Curriculum Information for Parents

Other
Reading books will be changed every Monday.

Maths
In Maths lessons, we will be: sorting and counting objects from groups, counting forwards, backwards and representing numbers to 10, finding one more and one less and looking at the composition of numbers up to 10.

Geography
In Geography, we will be naming and locating the continents of the world and the names of the seas and oceans. We will also be studying hot and cold countries close to the equator, as well as learning about animals in our country and different countries across the globe.

Technology
In our D&T lessons, we will be designing and creating a 'Sockasaurus' puppet. We will be working on our designing, evaluating and basic sewing skills.

Music
In Year 1, we will be following Charanga. Within our lessons, we will learn about the differences between pulse, pitch and rhythm. We will even be learning how to rap and appreciate Old School Hip-Hop tunes.

Science
In Science, we will be looking at animals. Children will be looking at the key features of birds, mammals, amphibians etc and labelling their different body parts.

Computing
This term, we will be researchers! We will be looking for animal pictures online. We will be gathering a collection of animal pictures that we will be sorting and presenting to the rest of the class.

R.E.
In RE, we will be looking at the Lord's Prayer, listening to it and figuring it out what it means. We will also be looking at Jesus and the Ten Lepers, describing the story and how Jesus used his powers to help.

KEY
P.E. will be on Wednesday (PE lesson) and Friday (Fitness)

English
Children will have a daily English lesson. We are learning how to extend our developing knowledge of sentence structure and punctuation. We will also be using a range of conjunctions such as 'and' and 'because'. We will have a daily Phonics session, with our main focus being Phase 5 sounds and Tricky Words.

History
In History, we will be answering the Enquiry Question 'Who am I?'. Children will think about how they have changed, make predictions and ask questions about their future and also see where they fit onto a simple timeline.

Art
We will begin our Art lessons by exploring colour mixing and applying this to printing dinosaur footprints. From this, we will use clay to produce a clay footprint.

P.E.
This term we are going to be Gymnasts! We will be concentrating on moving confidently in our spaces, exploring gymnastic shapes and movement as well as learning how to carry gymnastic equipment safely.
